One winner takes it all: money and international services. To go global!

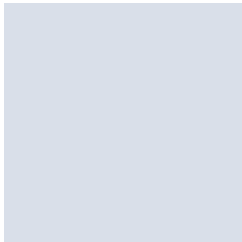

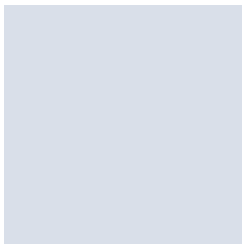
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
