The acquisition of Veolia Nordic's Utility Solutions business includes the energy production and energy O&M business in several locations in Sweden

and Norway. Moreover, Solör will enter O&M operations within municipal water and wastewater treatment. These combined activities will complete Solör's offering to its customers.
